## 2.a Fee Schedule Discussion

The City of Haines City's Charter; Article V; Section 5.01 (c) requires an ordinance for acts such as setting services or user charges for municipal services or to grant administrative authority for such charges; and Section 5.01 (c) specifically states that:

*Action requiring an ordinance.* In addition to other acts required by law or by specific provision of this Charter to be done by ordinance, those acts of the city commission shall be by ordinance which:

- (1) Establish a rule or regulation the violation of which carries a penalty;
- (2) Levy taxes authorized by general law;
- (3) Grant, renew or extend a franchise;
- (4) Set service or user charges for municipal services or grant administrative authority for such charges;
- (5) Amend or repeal any ordinance previously adopted, except as otherwise provided in Article X, with respect to repeal of ordinances reconsidered under the referendum power.

**Board Member Cohan** asked where the money is coming from for the programs. and if the deficit continuing to grow.

**Board Chair Starks** asked if the gap measure comes from the state and if there's a program available for people who can't afford these program fees.

**Board Member Cohan** asked when the last time was the fees where adjusted and if there is anyone who reviews the fees. she would love to see a comparison with other cities.

**Board Chair Starks** asked they can bring back their recommendations for the fees to the next schedule.

**Board Member Anthony Jones** said that in comparison to the surrounding cities, these fees are very fare.

**Board Member Cohan** said she would love to see the board's recommendations.

**Board Member Raggs** said he doesn't believe that it is a good time to raise the fees on the residents

**Parks and Recreation Director Griffin** said that he will bring it back to the next meeting to allow the board time to review and make suggestions.

**Board Member Anthony Jones** said times are tough right now due to inflation, but kids are keeping up with the trends.

**RESOLUTION 20-XXXX**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HAINES CITY, FLORIDA;  
AMENDING THE FEE SCHEDULE FOR CHARGES ASSOCIATED  
WITH DEPARTMENTAL PROCEDURES OR PROCESSES;  
PROVIDING FOR THE INCORPORATION OF RECITALS;  
PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS; EXERCISING THE USE OF  
GRANTED ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY; PROVIDING FOR  
THE CITY CLERK TO KEEP A COPY OF THE UPDATED FEE  
SCHEDULE ON FILE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF  
RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR  
SCRIVENERS ERRORS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND  
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

*WHEREAS*, the City of Haines City’s Charter; Article V; Section 5.01 (c) requires an ordinance for acts such as setting services or user charges for municipal services or to grant administrative authority for such charges; and Section 5.01 (c) specifically states that:

*Action requiring an ordinance.* In addition to other acts required by law or by specific provision of this Charter to be done by ordinance, those acts of the city commission shall be by ordinance which:

- (1) Establish a rule or regulation the violation of which carries a penalty;
- (2) Levy taxes authorized by general law;
- (3) Grant, renew or extend a franchise;
- (4) Set service or user charges for municipal services or grant administrative authority for such charges;
- (5) Amend or repeal any ordinance previously adopted, except as otherwise provided in Article X, with respect to repeal of ordinances reconsidered under the referendum power.

*WHEREAS*, on September 22, 2016, by Ordinance Number 16-1539, the City Commission formally adopted user fees and charges by ordinance and provided the authority to set or amend user fees and charges by resolution in the future; and

*WHEREAS*, the departmental service or user charges for municipal services that were already established by Ordinance 16-1539 cannot be changed unless amended by a fee schedule resolution; and

*WHEREAS*, the first amendment to the fee schedule was approved by Resolution 16-1228 on November 7, 2016 and the second amendment to the fee schedule was approved by Resolution 17-1292 on November 16, 2017; and

*WHEREAS*, the Third amendment to the fee schedule was approved by Resolution 18-

1326 on August 2, 2018.

**WHEREAS**, the Fourth amendment was approved by Resolution 19-1359; and

**WHEREAS**, the Fifth Amendment was approved by Resolution 19-1437; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Commission to approve the Sixth Amendment to the fee schedule.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City of Haines City, Florida, as follows:

**Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals.** The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2. Amendment to the Fee Schedule.** The fee schedule for service and user charges for municipal services associated with Departmental procedures or process, attached hereto as “Exhibit A” (the “Fee Schedule”) is hereby amended.

**Section 3. Exercising Use of Administrative Authority.** With the adoption of Ordinance No. 16-1539, it established the City of Haines City’s Fee Schedule. The Ordinance granted administrative authority for amendments to be made to service or user charges for municipal services by Resolution.

**Section 4. Providing for the Fee Schedule to be kept on File.** The fee schedule shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

**Section 5. Repeal of Resolutions in Conflict.** All other resolutions of the City of Haines City, Florida, or portions thereof which conflict with this or any part of this resolution are hereby repealed.

**Section 6. Scriveners Errors.** The correction of typographical, facility name changes, and/or scrivener’s errors which do not affect the legislative intent may be authorized by the City Manager or City Clerk or his/her designee, without the need of a public hearing, by filing corrected or re-codified copy of the same with the City Clerk.

**Section 7. Severability.** If any provision or portion of this Resolution is declared by any court of competent jurisdiction to be void, unconstitutional, or unenforceable, then all remaining provisions and portions of this Resolution shall remain in full effect.

**Section 8. Effective Date.** The Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the City Commission of the City of Haines City.
