

RESOLUTION NO. 23-1773

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HAINES CITY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF STANDARDS AND TECHNOLOGY'S CYBERSECURITY FRAMEWORK AS THE CYBERSECURITY STANDARD FOR THE CITY OF HAINES CITY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 282.3185, the “Local Government Cybersecurity Act,” establishes cybersecurity requirements for county and municipal governments; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 282.3185 (4) states, “Each local government shall adopt cybersecurity standards that safeguard its data, information technology, and information technology resources to ensure availability, confidentiality, and integrity. The cybersecurity standards must be consistent with generally accepted best practices for cybersecurity, including the National Institute of Standards and Technology Cybersecurity Framework;” and

WHEREAS, Florida Statute 282.3185 (4) requires municipalities with a population of 25,000 or more to adopt a cybersecurity standard by January 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Technology Management Department of the City of Haines City, Florida, has selected the National Institute of Standards and Technology’s Cybersecurity Framework as a baseline cybersecurity standard to which all cybersecurity policies of the City of Haines City, Florida, will adhere.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF HAINES CITY, FLORIDA, That:

SECTION ONE. The National Institute of Standards and Technology’s Cybersecurity Framework shall be the guiding cybersecurity standard for all cybersecurity policies adopted by the City of Haines City, Florida and the Technology Management Department.

SECTION TWO. The City Manager or his designee is hereby authorized to affirm compliance with Section 282.3185, Florida Statutes, via the Florida Digital Service portal before the January 1, 2024 deadline.

SECTION THREE. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
